How does this affect the reader's view of this "new literary hero" Sherlock Holmes? Or the reader's view of Holmes's friend, a doctor, and their relationship?
- **"The Strange Story of Jonathan Small"** In the first two Holmes novels, the villain comes from overseas to wreak havoc upon England. What is the effect of this narrative choice?
